PERSONAL INFORMATION WE COLLECT AND WHY WE COLLECT IT

Personal information is information that identifies, relates to, describes, is reasonably capable of being associated with, or could reasonably be linked, directly or indirectly, to you. Personal information does not include information that is publicly available, de-identified, or aggregated.

The categories of personal information we collect are shown in the chart below. Note that the specific pieces of personal information we collect about you may vary depending on the nature of your interactions with us and may not include all of the examples listed.

We may also collect some personal information about you that does not directly fit within one of the above categories. For example, we may collect the contents of communications you send to us by phone, email, text, online chat, etc. We use the information included in your communications to communicate with you about our Service, updates to our terms and policies, and to obtain your feedback; to provide customer service and support; to improve our Service and marketing; and to detect and prevent fraud against you and/or us.

In addition to the purposes described above, we may use and disclose any category of personal information we collect to respond to valid law enforcement requests, or as otherwise required or authorized by applicable law, valid court order, or governmental regulations; to protect our rights and interests and those of others; to resolve any disputes; to enforce our policies; and to evaluate or conduct a merger, sale, or other acquisition of some or all of our asset. We may use and share information for any purpose if it is publicly available, de-identified, or aggregated with other information so that it can no longer identify you.

TECHNOLOGIES THAT AUTOMATICALLY COLLECT INFORMATION ABOUT YOU

As shown in the chart above, we collect your personal information through various means, including through technologies that automatically collect information about you when you use our Service.

Cookies and Tracking Technologies. We use cookies and other tracking technologies (such as web beacons) to collect and store information about your interactions with our website, including information about your browsing behavior. Our website also supports third-party cookies placed by our service providers and advertising partners.

Cookies are small files that a website transfers to your device through a web browser that enable the site's or a third party's systems to recognize your device and capture and remember certain

information about your device and browsing activity. Web beacons (also known as tracking pixels) are tiny graphics embedded invisibly on a webpage or in an email that may be used to deliver or communicate with cookies, to count users who have visited certain pages, and to understand usage patterns. In general, our website uses cookies and other tracking technologies as follows:

- Where necessary to run our website.
- For analytics purposes—for example, to help us understand how our website is used, and to identify the pages and features that most interest you. More information on website analytics is provided below.
- For marketing and advertising.
- To optimize the functionality of our website, including by personalizing content for you, and remembering your preferences (e.g., your choice of language).
- To determine if our email messages have been opened and acted upon.

Cookies vary in how long they last. "Session cookies" terminate shortly after you terminate your internet session. "Persistent cookies" are stored on your device until a set expiration date. We use both session cookies and persistent cookies on our website.

If you do not want to have cookies placed on your device, you should set your browser to refuse cookies before accessing our website. Please review your browser's Help menu for instructions, or visit <u>www.allaboutcookies.org</u> for more information. Please note that, if you disable all cookies, some features of our website may not function properly.

Depending on your device settings, you may restrict certain interest-based advertising through the device's "Limit Ad Tracking" or equivalent feature. Refer to your device for more information on these features. You can also set your browser to refuse cookies from websites, but if you do so, you may not be able to access or use portions of our Services, and certain offerings on our Services may not function as intended or as well.

Analytics. We may use analytics to better understand how users interact with our website. This software may collect information such as your IP address, location, browser type and language, operating system, access time, duration of visit, pages you view within our website, search terms you enter, and other actions you take while visiting us, the pages you view immediately before and after you access our website, how often you use our website, aggregated usage and performance data, application errors, and debugging information.

Social Features. Certain features on our Service permit you to connect our Service with third-party services, such as social networks ("Social Features").
